Course Overview

Around the world, elections are often flashpoints for unrest, mistrust, and disinformation. This course helps participants build skills for early warning, dialogue, and community resilience to ensure elections are both peaceful and credible.

From understanding the roots of voter mistrust to organizing peaceful civic action, this course draws on real-world experiences and conflict transformation frameworks used globally. It connects voter protection with grassroots peacebuilding strategies that foster trust and collaboration.

The training combines group discussions, role-play simulations, case studies, and self-reflection to empower citizens, leaders, and election workers to be proactive champions of peace and voter rights in their communities.

Participants will explore tools to promote transparency, reduce political tensions, and engage with electoral systems in ways that promote lasting democracy and stability.

Course Objectives

This course aims to provide a strong foundation for election actors and community leaders to safeguard voter integrity, respond to potential electoral conflict, and foster dialogue and trust within their environment.

- Promote understanding of voter rights and common integrity threats
- Equip participants to prevent and manage election-related tensions
- Introduce tools for conflict transformation in political settings
- Strengthen peaceful engagement through active citizenship and dialogue
- Encourage trust-building strategies for pre- and post-election environments
